

General Information

The Apalachicola Antique & Classic Boat Show will be held in the historic city of Apalachicola in the Panhandle of Florida. We are expecting about 3,000 people. The show will be held outdoors next to the river front on a paved surface. Each space is approximately 12 x 12. Parking will be available near booths. Each artist is responsible for setting up their own exhibit space and must provide their own display tents and props. The display must be suitable for outdoors and able to withstand wind and crowds. The show will be limited to 20 artists and fine craftsmen whose work is of high quality and nautical in theme.

Set-up will begin Saturday morning at 8:00 a.m. All booths should be set up by 10:00 am. Saturday, April 24th. The artist agrees to set-up and remain set-up through the duration of the show which will end Saturday evening at 4:00 p.m. Each artist is responsible for collecting Florida State sales tax (7%) and remitting it to the Florida Department of Revenue.

All entries must be received by April 18, 2010 A completed application is a commitment to exhibit at the festival.

Eligibility

Categories accepted: Paintings -oil, acrylics & watercolor, graphics, glass, fiber, printmaking & collage, jewelry, metalwork, paper, clay, wood, mixed media, sculpture, photography. All works must be original works of art by the artist. Prints and reproductions must be labeled as such and be limited editions, numbered and signed by the artist. All works should be mounted or framed or must be displayed in a portfolio.

Specifically excluded are imports, commercial kits, manufacture or mass-produced items, dried flower arrangements, pour molds. The Apalachicola Bay Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to remove unsuitable works at any time during the festival.
